The judgment dated November 03, 2017 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal Nos. 17869-17870 of 2017 along with other cases has created confusion as to the legal effect of the judgment upon The Council of Engineering & Technology (India) i.e. CET(I).

In this regard it is to be clarified that The Council of Engineering & Technology (India) i.e. CET(I) is a professional society of engineers (Autonomous Body) running as per the present policy of AICTE, Govt. of India vide Ref. No: .F:/Dir(Acad)/Recognition/Syllabi/2012/695 on dated 26/07/2012. CET(I) offers non corporate/student membership, by conducting DIPCET(I) (Diploma Level) & AMCET(I) (Degree Level) Examinations through personal contact mode or self professional mode.

The Council of Engineering & Technology (India) i.e. CET (I) has initiated a Writ Petition being No. W.P. (C) of 2015 before the Hon'ble High Court at Delhi. In the said writ petition, the Hon'ble High Court at Delhi was pleased to pass an order dated November 15, 2017 whereby granted six months time to AICTE to lay down policy guidelines regarding the affiliation of professional societies in India, impacting the Judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and further directed to submit the same in the form of Affidavit to the Hon'ble Court. Which clarify the stand of professional Body/Society/Institution.

This is issued to clear the doubt, if any, at all, in the public mind.

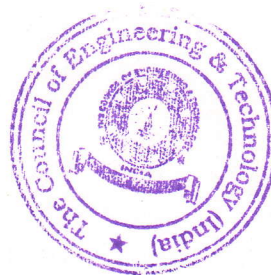
